It was moved by Hecht and seconded by Drake to approve an application for construction across an established Sac County drainage district submitted by Schaller Telephone Company. Ayes all, motion carried. The proposed work is located in Drainage District 59, Section 4 of Boyer Valley Twp.

It was moved by Drake and seconded by Hecht to approve an application to construction across an established Sac County Drainage District submitted by lowa Network Services. Ayes all, motion carried. The proposed work is located along the right of ways of Taylor Ave and 190th Streets, all in Section 15, Douglas Twp. The proposed work site is within the boundaries of Joint DD 16-30-92, Sac County Tile Branch.

Michael McCauley, Account Manager and Kelly Lester, Senior Account Service Representative with Wellmark Blue Cross and Blue Shield, were present to discuss and explain a $31.97 \%$ increase in the County's group health care coverage. Tom Scheutz, Sac County's third party administrator from Group Services was also present. Several options regarding premiums were offered. No action on the renewal was taken.
