The Board addressed a concern regarding a Drainage District Utility permit in DD60 for Hallett Materials in reference to dewatering methods at the Boyer Pit. Supervisor Stock and Hallett Materials have been in contact in an effort to employ methods to minimize the effect of such dewatering on the local water table. Supervisor Stock will contact the DNR regarding regulations and monitoring of water table depths and quality.
