It was moved by Hecht and seconded by Stock to approve the request for the Mike Brinkman site. Ayes all, motion carried.

Clarence Hoffman with IMWCA visited with the Board about insurance matters including the Sac County Safety Committee, workman's comp insurance and cyber liability. No action was taken.
