The Sac County Board of Supervisors met in regular session with all members present, Rick Hecht, Chairman, presiding. The minutes of the last meeting were approved as submitted.

It was moved by Stock and seconded by Drake to approve the agenda as posted. Ayes all. Motion carried.

Adam Ledford, Sac City Administrator, appeared before the Board requesting that taxes be abated on the property located at 305 W Main Street, Sac City, the location of the Freedom Rock. The City of Sac City has recently acquired the property and it will be moved to park status so it will become exempt property. It was moved by Stock and seconded by Drake to abate the taxes on the property located at 305 W Main Street, Sac City, in the amount of \$516.00. Ayes all. Motion carried.

Sheriff McClure introduced Alex Ladwig as the new Deputy in the Sac County Sheriff's Office and witnessed the Chairman administer the oath of office to Deputy Ladwig.

John Paulin with the NRCS office updated the Board as to the status of the Wetlands Restoration Project in Section 15, Viola Township on the Derrick Franck property. A tile investigation is in process and the NRCS will update the Board as to the results of that tile investigation.

The County Engineer updated the Board on activities of the county road crews and the status of current maintenance and construction projects.

It was moved by Drake and seconded by Stock to approve a Resolution to set the date and time for Road Vacation Hearing for 373rd Street in Section 20, Sac Township to be October 20, 2015 at 11:00am in the Board Room of the Sac County Courthouse.
