The Sac County Board of Supervisors met in regular session with all members present, Dean Stock, Chairman, presiding. The minutes of the last meeting were approved as submitted.

It was moved by Drake and seconded by Hecht to approve the agenda as posted. Ayes all, motion carried.

Amanda Milligan, Executive Director of the 2nd Judicial District Department of Corrections introduced herself and two staff members and a brief review of the statistics for that office.

At 10:30, as advertised, the Chairman opened the public hearing on the first reading of a proposed ordinance prohibiting the unlawful use of engine and compression brakes in certain area within the County. There was no one present to support or oppose the proposed ordinance. Supervisor Hecht indicated that he had had several conversations with residents in support of the proposed ordinance.

It was moved by Hecht and seconded by Drake to close the public hearing. Ayes all, motion carried.

It was moved by Hecht and seconded by Drake to waive the second and third reading and adopt the ordinance prohibiting the unlawful use of engine and compression brakes on County Road N 28 between one mile north and one mile south of the intersection of County Roads N28 and D36 effective immediately upon publication of the ordinance. Ayes Hecht, Drake and Stock; nays none, motion carried.

Jim Bullock, Sac County EMA Director, updated the Board on activities in his department. He will be working on a protocol to rescue large animals in the event of a semi-tractor-trailer roll over.

The County Engineer updated the Board on activities of the county road crews and the status of current maintenance and construction projects.

It was moved by Hecht and seconded by Drake to approve application for an 8" tile crossing between Sections 8 & 9 of Levey Twp. Ayes all, motion carried.

With there being no further business, on motion, the meeting was adjourned.
