The Sac County Board of Supervisors met in regular session with all members present, Ranell Drake, Chairman, presiding. The minutes of the last meeting were approved as submitted.

It was moved by Stock and seconded by Hecht to approve the agenda as posted. Ayes all, motion carried.

It was moved by Hecht and seconded by Stock to approve a 36% levy on DD 6 to generate \$947.53 for outstanding warrants and \$500.00 sinking fund. Ayes all, motion carried.

It was moved by Stock and seconded by Hecht to approve an 18% levy on DD 22 to generate \$1,134.40 for outstanding warrants and \$500.00 sinking fund. Ayes all, motion carried.

It was moved by Hecht and seconded by Stock to approve a 30% levy on DD 27 to generate \$872.18 for outstanding warrants and \$500.00 sinking fund. Ayes all, motion carried.

It was moved by Stock and seconded by Hecht to approve a 93% levy on DD 33 Br C & consent Br 1 to generate \$993.05 for outstanding warrants and \$500.00 sinking fund. Ayes all, motion carried.

It was moved by Hecht and seconded by Stock to approve a 43% levy on DD 39 to generate \$1,017.34 for outstanding warrants and \$500.00 sinking fund. Ayes all, motion carried.

It was moved by Stock and seconded by Hecht to approve a 126% levy on DD 58 to generate \$868.53 for outstanding warrants and \$500.00 sinking fund. Ayes all, motion carried.
