Representatives from the City of Lake View and members of the Black Hawk Lake Preservation Association presented a review of revenue and expenditures concerning the aquatic vegetation harvester and the application of aquatic herbicides in 2017 and a request for funding for 2018. Ben Wallace with the Department of Natural Resources gave a brief condition of the lake.

It was moved by Stock and seconded by Hecht to fund the aquatic harvester project and the aquatic herbicide project a total of up to \$15,000 if needed for the summer of 2018. Ayes all, motion carried.
