The Sac County Board of Supervisors met in regular session with all members present, Jim Wissler, Chairman, presiding. The minutes of the last meeting were approved as submitted.

It was moved by Fischer and seconded by Drake to approve the agenda as posted. Ayes all, motion carried.

It was moved by Drake and seconded by Fischer to table any action regarding a funding request in the amount of \$1,250.00 for cost related to the aquatic harvester for Blackhawk Lake in 2023, pending further information.

The County Engineer updated the Board on activities of the county road crews and the status of current maintenance and construction projects.

It was moved by Drake and seconded by Fischer to approve the drainage claims as submitted. Ayes all, motion carried.

Chairman Wissler opened the Public Hearing Regarding Disposition of County Property. County Attorney, Ben Smith explained to the Board that 1.56 acres in the SW¼ SW¼ of Section 16, T88N, R35W, has been owned by the County since 1912, although there is no clear understanding of why the county owns this sliver of land in a parcel belonging to Greg Schnirring. There were two people present to support the vacation of this property and no one was present to oppose it.

After some discussion, it was moved by Fischer and seconded by Drake to close the Public Hearing. Ayes all, motion carried.

It was moved by Drake and seconded by Fischer to Adopt a Resolution to Vacate the property legally described as 1.56 acres in the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 16, Township 88 North, Range 35 West of the 5th PM, Sac County, Iowa, and to direct the County Attorney to prepare a deed to the adjacent property owner, being Greg Schnirring. Ayes: Drake, Fischer, Wissler. Nays: none. Motion carried.
