The Sac County Sheriff discussed a proposal with the Board to provide contract law enforcement protection to the City of Schaller offering three options to cover the cost. It was moved by Hecht and seconded by Stock to offer option two to the City of Schaller where the County would add one more patrol deputy, include one half of the cost of the additional staff in the Sheriff's budget and figure in the second half of expense into the formula used to assess five communities for that service. Also included in the motion was to eliminate a part-time position in the uniform patrol service. Ayes all, motion carried.

Kathy Evert, the Sac County Hometown Pride coach, gave a brief report on the Home Town Pride activities throughout Sac County.

The County Engineer updated the Board on activities of the county road crews and the status of current maintenance and construction projects.

Melvin and Judy Buse were present to inquire about vacating a portion of 373<sup>rd</sup> Street. Most of the road has been removed and utilities have been relocated. No further action was taken.
