Brian Blomme, Sac County Drainage Engineer, updated the Board on the North Raccoon River Welands Initiative and the Iowa Nutrient Research & Education Council.

It was moved by Fischer and seconded by Drake to notify the Clay County Auditors office of Sac County's continued support of the North Raccoon River Wetlands Initiative proposal and forward same to the Iowa Department of Land Stewardship. Ayes all, motion carried.

The County Engineer updated the Board via email of the activities of the county road crews and the status of current maintenance and construction projects.

The Auditor updated the Board on increases on the County's replacement cost coverage which was estimated to be between \$3500 and \$4000 for the non-licensed vehicles in the Secondary Road department.
