The County Engineer updated the Board on activities of the county road crews and the status of current maintenance and construction projects.

Taylor Steinkamp, Sac County IT Director reviewed a proposal from Corn Belt Telephone Company for telephone and internet service for the courthouse and the cost savings as a result.

It was moved by Wissler and seconded by Drake to direct Mr. Steinkamp to proceed with the transfer of service from Frontier Communications to Corn Belt Telephone. Ayes all, motion carried.

It was moved by Wissler and seconded by Drake to approve the claims as listed on the claims register in the Auditor's office. Ayes all, motion carried.
