The Sac County Board of Supervisors met in regular session with all members present, Ranell Drake, Chairman, presiding. The minutes of the last meeting were approved as submitted.

It was moved by Stock and seconded by Hecht to approve the agenda as posted. Ayes all, motion carried.

The Board acknowledged receipt of a check in the amount of \$20,000 received from the Iowa Corn Growers Association to help defray some of the outstanding bills from the Des Moines Water Works lawsuit. The Board expressed their gratitude.

Brandy Ripley, Director of the SETD, updated the Board on the status of the Fireball Run activities which will be in Sac City on September 28.

It was moved by Hecht and seconded by Stock to approve the claims as listed on the claims register in the Auditor's office. Ayes all, motion carried.

Chris Hansen, Librarian from the Schaller Library, addressed the Board with questions regarding budgeting procedures for the local libraries and fund balances.

Brian Blomme, Engineer with the I&S Group, gave his preliminary report on the status of Drainage District 48 as a result of a petition for repairs submitted by some landowners in that district.

It was moved by Hecht and seconded by Stock to call an informational meeting with the landowners in DD 48 to discuss options for repairs on Tuesday, September 26, 2017, at 1:00 PM in the conference of the Sac County Law Enforcement Center. Ayes all, motion carried.

The County Engineer updated the Board on activities of the county road crews and the status of current maintenance and construction projects.
