

RESOLUTION # 22-0920

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING DOCUMENTS PERTAINING TO SAC COUNTY'S COMPLIANCE WITH TITLE VI PROVISIONS OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964.

WHEREAS, Sac County has been a recipient of federal financial assistance from the U.S. Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, in receiving such financial assistance Sac County is mandated to comply with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964; and

WHEREAS, the Iowa Department of Transportation has directed Sac County to adopt certain documents and put certain programs into place in order to comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964; and

WHEREAS, in order to continue receiving federal financial assistance from the U.S. Department of Transportation the adoption of certain documents and establishment of certain programs is necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Sac County that:

1. The County Engineer, Nick Buse, is hereby designated the Title VI Coordinator and ADA Coordinator for Sac County.
2. The *Sac County Title VI Agreement* is hereby adopted and that the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors and Title VI Coordinator are authorized to sign said agreement where required.
3. The *Standard DOT Title VI Assurances* are hereby adopted and that the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors is authorized to sign said document where required.
4. The *Title VI Notice to the Public* is hereby adopted and shall be posted where other public notices are displayed in the Sac County Administration Building and County Engineer's Office. Furthermore, said notice shall be placed on the County's official website.
5. The Title VI Coordinator is authorized to take any other actions necessary and/or recommended by the Iowa Department of Transportation, U.S. Department of Transportation, or other designated authority to comply with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.


