

**RESOLUTION NO. 26-0224**  
**ESTABLISHMENT OF A 5 TON EMBARGO**

**WHEREAS**, under the provisions of Chapter 321.471 and 321.472 of the Code of Iowa, the Board of Supervisors may establish a road embargo on the Secondary Road System, and

**WHEREAS**, due to a state bridge replacement project on State Highway 39, preventative measures are being taken to deter excessive detour traffic on County Road M35 which would cause severe deterioration and damage to the road.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Sac County Board of Supervisors that the County Engineer be authorized to order County Road M35 from 360<sup>th</sup> St. to 400<sup>th</sup> St. closed to vehicles in excess of five (5) tons per axle for the period of time deemed expedient (not to exceed 90 days), by erecting signs in accordance with Section 321.472.


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the County Engineer may grant permits of exemption upon a showing that there is a need to move to market farm produce of the type subject to rapid spoilage or loss of value or to move to any farm feeds or fuel for home heating purposes.
