

RESOLUTION 22-1018

SAC COUNTY PRECINCT ELECTION OFFICIAL COMPENSATION POLICY

WHEREAS, the Sac County Board of Supervisors does acknowledge the importance of Precinct Election Officials in the Election Process.

WHEREAS, the Sac County Board of Supervisors approve the following hourly rates for Precinct Election Officials effective October 1, 2022.

<u>Position</u>	<u>Recommended Salary</u>
Precinct Election Official	\$15.00/Hour

WHEREAS, the Sac County Board of Supervisors approves a mileage rate for all election workers that travel more than 5 miles one-way for service in an election following the standard County mileage reimbursement rate.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sac County Board of Supervisors adopts the salary recommendations for the previously listed workers, which will remain in effect until a new compensation policy is passed.

BE IT DULY ADOPTED this 18th day of October, 2022, with the vote thereon being as follows:


