It was moved by Fischer and seconded by Drake to adopt Resolution 23-0822B, to accept the low bid of \$90,600.00 submitted by Nelson & Rock for bridge abutment repair, project L-RI-2701—73-81 and authorize the County Engineer to sign and execute contracts for the project. Ayes Drake, Fischer and Wissler; nays none, motion carried.

It was moved by Drake and seconded by Fischer to approve pay application number 4 in the amount of \$42,624.04 to Reutzel Excavating for work done on Joint Drainage District 20, Sac and 119, Calhoun. Ayes all, motion carried.
