**ALL POLLS IN SAC COUNTY OPEN AT 7:00 A.M. AND WILL CLOSE AT 8:00 P.M.**

Pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a regular ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered, such as voters registering to vote on Election Day and voters changing precincts, must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification (or prove residence, if required) may have voter’s identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct, prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents, or cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the Sac County Auditor’s office by Monday, November 14, 2022, at 12:00pm. Election Day Registrant attestors must provide an approved form of identification. Voter pre-registration deadline is 5:00pm on Monday, October 24, 2022, at the Sac County Auditor’s office. Absentee ballots are available for in-person absentee voting in the Sac County Auditor’s office during regular business hours, 8:00am-4:30pm, Monday – Friday, beginning Wednesday, October 19, 2022. In addition to the normal business hours, the office will offer extended hours on Monday, May 23, 2022, and Friday, November 4, 2022, from 8:00am-5:00pm, as well as Saturday, November 5, 2022, from 9:00am-5:00pm. **Monday, October 24, 2022, is the last day absentee ballots can be MAILED to voters.** Absentee ballots cannot be mailed to persons who have not registered to vote. Unregistered voters may submit a completed voter registration form with their absentee ballot application if the completed forms will be received in the Auditor’s Office by Monday, October 24, 2022. Persons registering to vote after this date shall not be mailed an absentee ballot but may vote in person at the Sac County Auditor’s Office until 5:00pm on Monday, November 7, 2022, upon providing proof of identity and residency.
